# National Youth Omnium Series 2026

## Round 2 - Herne Hill

### Welcome

VC Londres are excited to welcome riders to our regular round of the National Youth Omnium Series at Herne Hill Velodrome for another year. The velodrome has a long and illustrious past, as it was built in 1891 and hosted Olympic Games in 1948. Our event will follow the format of the National Youth Omniums and will include a Time Trial, Scratch race, Elimination, Match Sprint and Points race.

Please familiarise yourself with the [Series Regulations](#) ahead of the day.

### Fear not the rain...

If you've been to our Omnium in the last few years, you already know that we can carry on racing in all but the most extreme weather conditions. Light to medium rain is not a problem, as our track has an all-weather surface and grip is easily maintained in wet weather. The weather forecast for Sunday is actually looking good, but riders should still come prepared for various conditions. You are welcome to bring gazebos/shelters (with weights!), which could be placed in the track centre and please dress appropriately for a long day of being outside.

### Getting here

Venue's address is 104 Burbage Rd, London SE24 9HE. For those travelling from outside of London, please be aware that Herne Hill Velodrome is inside the Ultra-Low Emission Zone (ULEZ). Cars need to meet [minimum emissions standards](#) when travelling within the ULEZ or the daily £12.50 charge must be paid.

There'll be some road closures in Central/Eastern London on the day owing to the London Marathon taking place. None of the closures happen close to the velodrome or impact any major thoroughfares leading to Herne Hill, so they shouldn't disrupt your travels. For your piece of mind, if traveling through Rotherhithe, Blackwall or Silvertown tunnels in the morning, use navigation apps (Google Maps, Waze etc) to avoid closed roads south of Thames.

Be aware that [charges now apply](#) to both the Blackwall and recently opened Silvertown tunnel.

Please don't arrive to the velodrome before 8.30am on the day and avoid queuing outside in front of locked gates – the venue will only open at this time, and we don't want to disrupt street traffic and disturb local residents.

The Velodrome offers free parking – please look out for our car park marshals who'll provide you with directions. Blue Badge parking spaces are available – please kindly let us know beforehand if you're a Blue Badge holder and require a designated space.

## Facilities and spectating

Herne Hill Velodrome has plenty of space in the stands and we encourage all parents to spectate from there, leaving the track centre to riders. The velodrome Jan's Café will be open throughout the event, serving hot drinks, snacks and limited hot food.

Changing rooms and toilets are available inside the velodrome's pavilion on the ground level. Additional toilet is also available outside in the track centre. Drinking water fountains can be found in changing rooms and in track centre by the First Aid tent and the judging stand.

All track crossing during the day will be carried out via the derry gate. Please exercise caution when crossing the track at all times and remain alert to on-track activity. Instructions from gate marshals must be followed at all times.

Starting pistol will be fired repeatedly in the track centre during the opening event (Time Trial) – be mindful of potential acoustic discomfort and consider either being in the stands or using ear protection.

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead (make sure to remove any waste).

## Gear Checks and Equipment

Pre-race gear check and sign-on will be open from 8.45 to 10am. Riders must bring their BC license to sign on – either on the phone, or printed out. Additional spot checks will be carried out throughout the event across all categories – riders should proceed to the gear check in the holding area immediately if called.

Gear restrictions will be enforced as per current British Cycling technical regulations:

Youth C (U12) - 6.34m

Youth B (U14) - 6.73m

Youth A (U16) - 7.18m

Any riders born in 2016 who are riding up in Youth C group should adhere to the relevant gear limit (6.34m).

No additional equipment (spare sprocket, camera etc) should be kept on the bike. Spare bikes are not permitted, only one bike to be used at the event

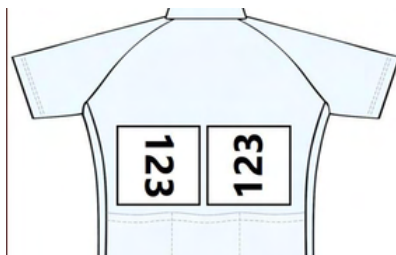
Only Youth A riders can use deep section and disc wheels (for the last year!), while Youth B and Youth C groups are restricted to rim depths no greater than 40mm and 35mm, respectively.

During the Time Trial, Youth A riders may use tri-bars and arm extensions which comply with BC technical regulations.

## Race numbers

Riders will be issued with two numbers that must be worn as shown below for all events including Time Trial. Numbers must not be folded, torn or obscured in any way.

Numbers must be pinned on top of the jersey/skinsuit (pins will be provided).  
No transparent pockets or "speed-wraps" to be used for any races on the day.



Riders must proceed to the holding area when called by race marshals prior to the start of their race. For the Time Trial, riders must report to their designated start stations no later than the start of the preceding heat.

## Prizes

The top three finishers in each U14 and U16 category, as well as the U12 support event, will receive prizes provided by event organisers.

Special prizes will be awarded for the setting of new track records in the Time Trial event (see below).
